Have you ever wished to understand what your pet is really thinking? If so, consider turning to a pet psychologist. Pet psychologists are trained experts who can clue you in on your pet's emotions by studying its behavior. Pets experience feelings 51 humans do. They express their emotions through actions. For instance, a dog that tears up furniture may be reacting to boredom or anxiety, not simply misbehaving. 52, a cat without a quiet hiding spot might suffer from stress and sometimes act out aggressively. Social needs are especially important for dogs, as they are naturally inclined to live in packs where they learn communication and behavior through group interaction. In other words, social life helps shape a dog's behavior. As for smaller pets like birds or rabbits, 53 their size, their emotional needs can be just as complex. In the wild, many small animals tend to live in groups for safety and comfort. To 54 their needs, owners should keep more than one bird or rabbit or ensure that they have regular and consistent companionship. In short, at the heart of pet

psychology is the idea that pets are happiest and learn best when they feel safe, respected, and cared for. Understanding this helps owners build stronger bonds with their pets, based on trust and empathy.

Padel is the fastest growing sport in the world. Second only to soccer in popularity in Spain, the sport is gaining fans everywhere. It's a mix of squash and tennis but wilder and more fun than either. Like in tennis, in the middle of the padel court 55 a net. Yet, the court is smaller and is enclosed, much like a squash court. Players hit the ball back and forth over the net. But only underhand shots that bounce off the walls are fair game. The scoring is similar to tennis. These unique rules make the sport easy to learn, entertaining to watch and challenging to master. 56 many people fall in love with it.

There are many stories about how this exciting, action-packed sport came to be. Most agree that Mexican millionaire Enrique Corcuera and his wife built the first padel court. 57 the limited space on their property, the couple's engineer proposed building a tennis court one-third the standard size into the hillside and putting walls on the sides. Then, with the court completed in 1969, the couple began developing a new sport and invited many guests to try this new racket sport with them. In no time, the sport caught on. In 1991, Mexico hosted the first international padel event, the Corcuera Cup. Interest in the sport has continued to grow ever since.
